Entries must be stalled by 9 p.m., Wednesday, July 14, to 6:30 p.m. Sunday, July 18.

Livestock exhibits must be verified with fair superintendents Thursday, July 15 by 12 noon.

Health papers must be presented to the Department Superintendent or Fair Veterinarian.

Registration papers shall be presented for all entries on demand by the Department Superintendent. Registration papers are not needed for Class 17 - Commercial and Class 18 - Novice.

If less than five head per any one breed exhibited, we reserve the right to group them according to British, Continental, Dairy or Exotic Breeds. The decision of the Beef Superintendents and Todd County Ag Society Board is final.
