Class 60 - Artisan Specialties

No entry fee.

1. All exhibitors must be at least 21 years of age.
2. All wines must be home-brewed.
3. There is to be only one entry per class.
4. Fair staff and/or judges reserve the right to combine classes and to move any bottles that is entered in the wrong class. If that class has already been judged, the bottle will not be in contention.
5. Wine may be made from any berry, fruit, vegetable, grain or juice commonly used in the making of wine.
6. Each entry must be bottled in clean, standard 4/5 qt. or 750 ml wine bottle with cork, screw cap, or crown cap closures. No decanters are allowed.
7. Bottles must be labeled for content (chokecherry wine, apple, etc.) and type (sweet or dry) and recipe type if the recipe is not the original of the makers.
8. Judging will be on Bouquet, Appearance, Taste, Texture and Presentation.
